



Should I replace my wet Insulation?

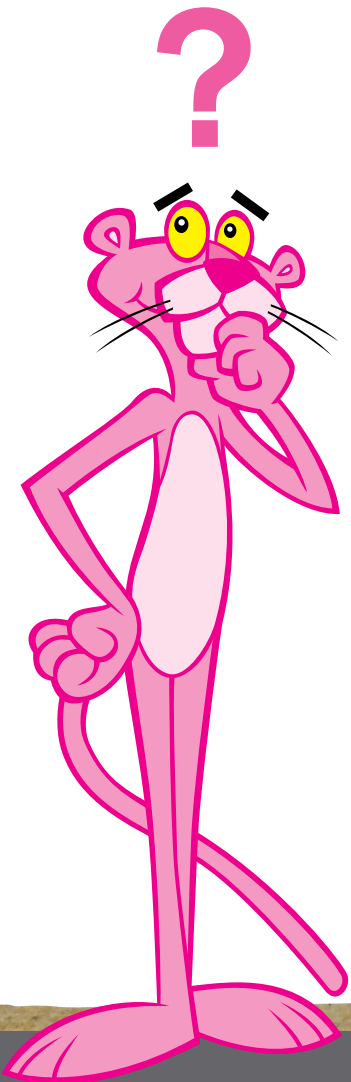
Our thoughts are with you as the effects of this recent storm continue to be felt. We hope you, your employees and your families are safe.

As you repair and rebuild, it is important to keep insulation top of mind.

Please note that fiberglass and mineral wool insulation can and does get wet at times and that wetting from **clean water** such as condensation will not affect the thermal value of the insulation once it dries and recovers its labeled thickness.

Water from flooding is not and cannot be considered clean. The potential contaminants from **unclean flood water** warrants the recommendation to dispose of any fiberglass or mineral wool insulation that comes in contact with flood water whether it is still in the packaging or installed due to the potential loss of thermal performance and the potential for contaminant issues.
